

## Canadian C-Spine Rule



	1. INCLUSION CRITERIA (check as applicable)  ALERT (GCS 15)  STABLE (SBP ≥90mmHg, respiratory rate 10-24/minute)  ACUTE BLUNT INJURY (<48 hours)  Are all the inclusion criteria met?  YES - CONTINUE to exclusion criteria  NO - STOP; can't use the Canadian C-Spine Rule
	ON CRITERIA (check as applicable)
<ul> <li>Boarded and collared for reason other than c-spine injury</li> </ul>	

2. EXCLUSION CRITERIA (check as applicable)		
	Boarded and collared for reason other than c-spine injury	
	Age <8 years	
	Penetrating trauma from stabbing or gunshot wound	
	Acute paralysis (paraplegia, quadriplegia)	
	Known vertebral disease (ankylosing spondylitis, rheumatoid arthritis, spinal stenosis, previous c-spine surgery)	
	Referred from another hospital
