CRISIS MOBILE TEAM EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- CTAS 1 patients
- · Patient with acute medical or surgical conditions
- · Patient actively attempted OD/Suicide
- · Patient that is hostile, aggressive, or actively attempting to cause harm to themselves and/or others
- Patient that meets criteria for LPS to apprehend the patient under the Mental Health Act

CRISIS MOBILE TEAM INCLUSION CRITERIA

- Age ≥16 years
- Patient is indicating refusal of treatment and/or transport, and understanding of explanations provided regarding the consequences of refusal (Capacity Evaluation)
- · Patient is suffering from anxiety disorders or emotional distress
- Patient/substitute decision maker refuse transport to emergency department
- · Patient/substitute decision maker is cooperative and gives informed consent to contact CMT

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CRISIS MOBILE TEAM REFERRAL

- 1. Identified potential CMT patient
- 2. Discuss the benefits of CMT referral with patient/substitute decision maker
- 3. Obtain patient or substitute decision maker's verbal consent for referral
- 4. Contact CACC on patch line (519-667-1433) and request "CMT patch"
 - o Request CMT for response
 - State patient name/D.O.B
 - Current location
 - Brief report on situation
 - o Does CMT accept/decline request to respond?
 - o ETA?
- If CMT accepts the request to respond the paramedics will wait on scene with the patient until CMT arrival
- 6. The attending paramedic will provide a verbal report with the corresponding Call# to the CMT
- The attending paramedic will complete a "ROS" with the patient/substitute decision maker and have a member of the CMT to sign as witness
- 8. The attending paramedic will complete and submit the ePCR to receiving facility "ROS CMT"
- 9. If CMT declines the patient at time of request, or after arriving on scene, the Paramedic will either:
 - Complete the ROS (no pt safety concern)
 - o Transport the patient in accordance with MLEMS Ambulance Destination Policy
 - Request LPS for apprehension under MHA if deemed necessary
