PATIENT REPATRIATION FOR LONDON AND MIDDLESEX

BACKGROUND

Patients who have been recently discharged from hospital are usually best served by returning to the same site, if they are returning for care of the same problem, or a seemingly related problem.

EXCLUSIONS

- CTAS 1
- Any hospital without an Emergency Department
- Patients with a problem seemingly unrelated to previous admission or surgery.

PROTOCOL

- 1. CTAS 2, 3, 4 or 5 patients will be returned to the ED of a facility if they:
 - a. have been discharged from an inpatient service at that facility within the past 14 days
 - b. have undergone surgery at that facility within the past 14 days
 - c. receive regular care at that facility (ex. Chemotherapy, hemodialysis, regular clinic visits)
