DEFINITION OF PAEDIATRIC PATIENT:

For the application of this protocol only, a pediatric patient is one who is:

- Seventeen (17) years of age or less as stated by:
 - a) the patient
 - b) from other people at the scene who know the patient
 - c) from personal identification
 - d) or failing the above, in the absence of secondary sexual characteristics (i.e. body hair, breast development)

EXCLUSIONS

 Paediatric patients in the County of Middlesex who are closer to a County Hospital Emergency Department

For patients being transported into the city of London, Paramedics are permitted to transport all
