Placement Summary

Middlesex-London Paramedic Service (MLPS) is currently accepting applications for 3rd and 4th semester college students interested in joining the Primary Care Paramedic Mentorship Program.

The successful candidates will be provided a mentorship placement within MLPS. Placements will be completed with a variety of paramedic mentors in various station locations. The successful candidates will receive continuous feedback throughout the process and receive continuing education opportunities. Placements will take place during the months of November 2023 through April 2024, in coordination with their respective Colleges. This process is competitive and not all applicants will be offered mentorship positions within the service.

There is no guarantee of employment after the placement has concluded, however the intention of this program is to develop and foster well-rounded paramedic students and assist them with the transition from student to independently practicing as a paramedic. The intent of this program is to present a conditional job offer to successful candidates.

- To participate in scenario and skill based clinical evaluation testing at Middlesex-London Paramedic Service. The testing process will occur on September 30 and October 1, 2023. Successful applicants will receive further information and testing date/time.
 - Have a valid CPR certificate (BLS or HCP).

Students accepted into the PCP Mentorship Program will be required:

- To have academic certification through the Southwest Ontario Regional Base Hospital Program (SWORBHP); Results of successful certification must be received no later than January 15, 2024.
 - To submit a completed Vulnerable Sector Police reference check
 - To provide immunization information in compliance with Ambulance Service Communicable Disease Standards Version 2.1-Table 1-Part A.
