Placement Summary

Middlesex-London Paramedic Service (MLPS) is currently accepting applications from third- and fourth-semester college students interested in joining our Paramedic Bridge Program.

Students will be placed with and work under the guidance of experienced paramedics at various station locations. Throughout their placement, participants will receive ongoing feedback and opportunities for continuing education to further develop their knowledge, skills, and confidence in the field.

Placements will take place from November 2026 through April 2027, in coordination with the students' respective colleges. The selection process is competitive, and not all applicants will be offered a placement with the Service. Placements are unpaid academic opportunities.

Participation in online training and Service training will also be provided as part of the program.

This opportunity provides valuable hands-on experience and is designed to support students as they transition from academic studies to independent practice. Participation in the Paramedic Bridge Program does not guarantee employment with MLPS following completion of the placement.

Our goal is to provide students with a strong foundation for future career success—from classroom to crew, where your career begins.

Education

- Currently attending 3rd or 4th semester or equivalent of an approved Ontario College Paramedic Program
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Ride-Out Placement Requirements

Students accepted into the Paramedic Bridge Program will be required:

- Have a valid CPR certificate (BLS or HCP).
- Have academic certification through the Southwest Ontario Regional Base Hospital Program (SWORBHP). Proof of successful certification must be received no later than January 15, 2027.
- Submit a completed Vulnerable Sector Search dated within 90 days of submission.
- Provide immunization information in compliance with the Ambulance Service Communicable Disease Standards, Version 2.1, Table 1, Part A.
